Important Note: It is the student's & parent's responsibility to see that the requirements for graduation from high school are met. Be sure to refer to the RRISD High School Course Catalog to ensure that your choices are appropriate for graduation requirements. The state requires academic interventions for students who demonstrate a need for additional academic assistance. In order to maximize student achievement, students in need of assistance will be reassigned to an academic intervention class in lieu of an elective. While every attempt will be made to honor students' elective selection, budget and enrollment considerations may affect actual course availability and offerings. Students who do not choose alternates will have alternates selected by the counselor.
